THE RESURGENCE OF THE CROWN

Acts 1:6-8

6 When they therefore were come together, they asked of him, saying, Lord, wilt thou at this time restore again the kingdom to Israel?

7 And he said unto them<mark>, It is not for you to know the times or the seasons, which the Father hath</mark> put in his own power.

8 <u>But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses</u> unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

1 Chronicles 17:11-14

11 It shall come to pass, when thy days be expired that thou must go to be with thy fathers, that I will raise up thy seed after thee, which shall be of thy sons; and I will establish his kingdom.

12 He shall build me an house, and I will stablish his throne forever.

13 I will be his father, and he shall be my son: and I will not take my mercy away from him, as I took it from him that was before thee:

14 But <mark>I will settle him in mine house and in my kingdom forever: and his throne shall be established</mark> <mark>for evermore.</mark>

Psalms 89:35-37

35 Once have I sworn by my holiness that I will not lie unto David.

36 His seed shall endure forever, and his throne as the sun before me.

37 It shall be established forever as the moon, and as a faithful witness in heaven. Selah.

Zechariah 9:9

Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he is just, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass.

Isaiah 9:6-7

6 For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.

7 Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even forever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.

Luke 1:30-33

30 The angel said unto her, Fear not, Mary: for thou hast found favour with God.

31 And, <u>behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name</u> <u>JESUS.</u>

32 <u>He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest</u>: <mark>and the Lord God shall give unto him</mark> the throne of his father David:

33 And he shall reign over the house of Jacob forever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end.

Acts 2:25-33

25 For David speaketh concerning him, I foresaw the Lord always before my face, for he is on my right hand, that I should not be moved:

26 Therefore did my heart rejoice, and my tongue was glad; moreover also my flesh shall rest in hope:
27 Because thou wilt not leave my soul in hell, <u>neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see</u> corruption. (Ps 16:8-10)

28 Thou hast made known to me the ways of life; thou shalt make me full of joy with thy countenance.
29 Men and brethren, let me freely speak unto you of the patriarch David, that he is both dead and buried, and his sepulchre is with us unto this day.

30 Therefore being a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him, that of the fruit of his loins, according to the flesh, he would raise up Christ to sit on his throne;

31 He seeing this before spake of the resurrection of Christ, that his soul was not left in hell, neither his flesh did see corruption.

32 This Jesus hath God raised up, whereof we all are witnesses.

33 Therefore being by the right hand of God exalted, and having received of the Father the promise of the Holy Ghost, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear.

Daniel 7:13-14

13 I saw in the night visions, and, behold, <u>one like the Son of man came with the clouds of</u> <u>heaven, and came to the Ancient of days</u>, and they brought him near before him.

14 And there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed.

Acts 13:33-35

33 God hath fulfilled the same unto us their children, in that he hath raised up Jesus again; as it is also written in the second psalm, Thou art my Son, this day have I begotten thee.

34 And as concerning that he raised him up from the dead, now no more to return to corruption, he said on this wise, I will give you the sure mercies of David.

35 Wherefore he saith also in another psalm, Thou shalt not suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.

Psalms 2:6-8

6 Yet have I set my king upon my holy hill of Zion.

7 <u>I will declare the decree: the LORD hath said unto me, Thou art my Son; this day have I begotten thee.</u>

8 Ask of me, and I shall give thee the heathen for thine inheritance, and the uttermost parts of the earth for thy possession.

Revelation 5:5-6

5 And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: <u>behold, the Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of</u> David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.

6 And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.
