The Circle of the Crown

- "In the beginning **God created the heavens and the earth**. 2 The earth was without **form**, and **void**; and **darkness** was on the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters. 3 Then God said, "Let there be **light**"; and there was light." Genesis 1:1-3 NKJV
- · God created heaven and earth at the same
- He made earth a reflection of heaven
- Strong's Definition Form: The tôhûw, to'-hoo; from an unused root meaning to lie waste; a desolation (of surface), i.e. desert; figuratively, a worthless thing; adverbially, in vain:—confusion, empty place, without form, nothing, (thing of) nought, vain, vanity, waste, wilderness.
- Strong's Definition Void: The bôhûw,bo'-hoo; from an unused root (meaning to be empty); a vacuity, i.e. (superficially) an undistinguishable ruin:—emptiness, void. Waste.
- Strong's Definition Darkness: | Triphchôshek, kho-shek'; from H2821; the dark; hence (literally) darkness; figuratively, misery, destruction, death, ignorance, sorrow, wickedness:—dark(-ness), night, obscurity.
- Strong's Definition Light: him 'ôwr, ore; from H215; illumination or (concrete) luminary (in every sense, including lightning, happiness, etc.):—bright, clear, day, light (-ning), morning, sun.light of lamp, light of life, light of prosperity, light of instruction, light of face (fig.), Jehovah as Israel's light

Who is present at the Creation of the World?

"In the beginning of **God's** preparing the heavens and the earth — 2 the earth hath existed waste and void, and darkness [is] on the face of the deep, and **the Spirit of God** fluttering on the face of the waters, 3 and **God saith**, '**Let light be**;' and **light is.**" Genesis 1:1-3 YLT98

- Verse 1 God (Elohim)
- Verse 2 Spirit of God
 - o God does nothing without the Holy Spirit, His Presence first
- Verse 3 Word of God Jesus
 - "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning. Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made." John 1:1-3 NIV

But we also learn from Proverbs 8:22-31 that Wisdom was there

- ""The LORD created and possessed me at the beginning of His way, Before His works of old [were accomplished]. 23 From everlasting I was established and ordained, From the beginning, before the earth existed, [I, godly wisdom, existed]. 24 When there were no ocean depths I was born, When there were no fountains and springs overflowing with water. 25,Before the mountains were settled, Before the hills, I was born; 26 While He had not yet made the earth and the fields, Or the first of the dust of the earth.
- 27 When He established the heavens, I [Wisdom] was there; When He drew a circle upon the face of the deep, 28 When He made firm the skies above, When the fountains and springs of the deep became fixed and strong, 29 When He set for the sea its boundary So that the waters would not transgress [the boundaries set by] His command, When He marked out the foundations of the earth— 30 Then I was beside Him, as a master craftsman; And I was daily His delight; Rejoicing before Him always, 31 Rejoicing in the world, His inhabited earth, And having my delight in the sons of men." God draws a circle on the face of the deep

- "When He established the heavens, I [Wisdom] was there; When He drew a circle upon the face of the deep," Proverbs 8:27 AMP
- Strong's Definition Circle: মান chûwg,khoog; from H2328; a circle:—circle, circuit, compass, sphere, vault (of the heavens)

- Strong's Definition Deep: מְּהֹם teh-home'; or מְּהֹם teh-home; (usually feminine) from H1949; an abyss (as a surging mass of water), especially the deep (the main sea or the subterranean watersupply):—deep (place), depth.
- "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. 2 The earth was without form, and void; and **darkness was on the face of the deep**. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters. 3 Then God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light." Genesis 1:1-3 NKJV

Why did God draw a circle on the face of the deep?

- Because God had set a target of His faith to create the heavens and the earth and the circle allowed Him to focus on this creation.
- It is like having a goal post at the end of the football field for the kicker to target his faith to get the football through to win the game.

He was also setting His Crown on the Earth

- Strong's Definition Crown: אָטָרָהְ 'āṭârâh, at-aw-ra'; from H5849; a crown:—crown. Royal, a diadem, whatever is an ornament or dignity.
- Strong's Definition Root of Crown:
- huy 'âṭar, a-tare'; a primitive root; to encircle (for attack or protection); especially to crown (literally or figuratively):—compass, crown. Hebrew Root: To surround

In the Young's Literal Translation he actually decreed the circle...

"In His preparing the heavens I [am] there, In His decreeing a circle on the face of the deep," Proverbs 8:27 YLT98

In the King James he sets a compass

 "When he prepared the heavens, I was there: When he set a compass upon the face of the depth:" Proverbs 8:27 KJV

Then He spoke into circle

Then God said, "Let there be <u>light</u>"; and there was light." Genesis 1:3 NKJV
 O earth, earth, Hear the word of the LORD!" Jeremiah 22:29 NKJV

- "Listen, O heavens, and I will speak! Hear, O earth, the words that I say! Deuteronomy 32:1NLT
- "By faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that the things which are seen were not made of things which are visible." Hebrews 11:3 NKJV

Important Note:

- God did not do His speaking, until the Holy Spirit was there hovering:
 - The earth was without <u>form</u>, and <u>void</u>; and <u>darkness</u> was on the face of the deep. <u>And the Spirit of God was hovering</u> over the face of the waters. 3 <u>Then God said</u>, "Let there be <u>light</u>"; and there was light." Genesis 1:1-3 NKJV
- That is why we do not do our speaking until we are up the Mountian, in the Courts, in the Presence of God. For it is then we will only speak what He would have us say, His Word, highly charged and powerful.
 - "For the (spoken) word of God is alive and powerful. It is sharper than the sharpest two-edged sword, cutting between soul and spirit, between joint and marrow. It exposes our innermost thoughts and desires." Hebrews 4:12 NLT
 - Strong's Definition Word: λόγος lógos, log'-os; from G3004;
 something said
 - Strong's Definition Powerful: ένεργήςenergés, en-er-gace'; from G1722 and G2041; active, operative:—effectual, powerful.

For the Holy Spirit will Hover over that Word until there is Conception and then Manifestation

- "And the angel answered and said to her, " The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Highest will overshadow you; therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be born will be called the Son of God. 38 Then Mary said, "Behold the maidservant of the Lord! Let it be to me according to your (spoken) word." And the angel departed from her."

The Father is above the circle of heaven and earth

"Thick clouds cover Him, so that He cannot see, And **He walks above the <u>circle</u> of heaven**." Job 22:14 NKJVs

 "Thick clouds [are] a secret place to Him, And He doth not see;' And the <u>circle</u> of the heavens He walketh habitually," Job 22:14 YLT98

"It is He who sits above the <u>circle</u> of the earth, And its inhabitants are like grasshoppers, Who stretches out the heavens like a curtain, And spreads them out like a tent to dwell in." Isaiah 40:22 NKJV

- Sitting is a position of Kings for Rulership
 - "The LORD (Father) says to my Lord (the Messiah, His Son), "Sit at My right hand Until I make Your enemies a footstool for Your feet [subjugating them into complete submission]."" Psalms 110:1 AMP

Who is Wisdom

- "God has united you with Christ Jesus. For our benefit God made him to be wisdom itself. Christ made us right with God; he made us pure and holy, and he freed us from sin." 1 Corinthians 1:30 NLT
- I want them to be encouraged and knit together by strong ties of love. I want them to have complete confidence that they understand God's mysterious plan, which is Christ himself. 3 <u>In him</u> lie hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge. (Colossians 2:2-3 NLT)

Wisdom is the Master Craftsman

- Strong's Definition Delight: אַשְּיִשְשׁ sha'shua', shah-shoo'-ah; from H8173; enjoyment:—delight, pleasure.
- Strong's Definition Rejoicing: sâchaq, saw-khak'; a primitive root; to laugh (in pleasure or detraction); by implication, to play:—deride, have in derision, laugh, make merry, mock(-er), play, rejoice, (laugh to) scorn, be in (make) sport. Hebrew root: To laugh, to smile upon, to play, to dance (like an artist)
