THE MASTER'S KEY TO ANSWERED PRAYER

WHEN YOU PRAY - ABIDE AND ASK

John 15:7

If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.

At that day ye shall know that I am in my Father, and ye in me, and I in you.

John 16:23-24

WHEN YOU PRAY – UNDERSTANDING AND ACTIVATING THE PROCESS OF BELIEVING

Mark 11:22-24

22 Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God.

23 For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them (NIV - Believe that you have received it) and ye shall have them.

HEAR, RECEIVE, UNDERSTAND, KEEP THE WORD OF THE KINGDOM

Believing you have received constitutes shifting the interior realm of the heart into a place that "SEES, THAT I HAVE GIVEN"; with imagery, and at times feelings and a full persuasion that "YOU HAVE ALREADY RECEIVED IT." An interior picture, or a panoramic image must be created within via the entrance of the word of promise, abiding in Christ, the poetry of believing, keeping His word and perambulation. (Consider Noah and The Ark - Genesis 6:14-16)

To activate this type of believing, Faith must employed and activated to paint a finished image of what your believing for. It cannot be simple lip service or adolescent pride, saying "I GOT THIS". Remember, the word of the Lord is tried. It must be daily attended to by way of keeping the word, until the heart receives the full persuasion and speaks both that persuasion and image into the earth. Then you can have what you say. The finished image will be able to stand the test of patience, warfare, tribulation, persecutions, criticisms, intense circumstantial doubt, offenses, betrayals, trespasses, and all manner of atmospheric darkness. The finished word within the realm of the heart will be fully anchored and immovable, ready to be transplanted and activated into the realms of the earth controlled by the devil and darkness.
