## UNDERSTANDING THE MYSTERY OF FAITH

## Mark 11:22-24

22 And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God.

23 For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass (come into existence); he shall have whatsoever he saith.

24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire<mark>, when ye pray, believe that ye</mark> <mark>receive them</mark>, <u>and ye shall have them</u>.

- Believe You Receive You Shall Have
- Believe What You Say To Come Into Existence You Shall Have

## Romans 10:10

<mark>For with the heart man believeth</mark> unto righteousness; <mark>and with the mouth confession is</mark> made unto salvation.

Proverbs 18:21

Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.

## Luke 6:45

<mark>A good man out of the good treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is good</mark>; and an evil man out of the evil treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is evil: <mark>for of the</mark> <mark>abundance of the heart his mouth speaketh.</mark>

Luke 1:30-35

30 And the angel said unto her, Fear not, Mary: for thou hast found favour with God.

31 And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name JESUS.

32 <u>He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: <mark>and the Lord God shall</mark> give unto him the throne of his father David:</u>

33 And he shall reign over the house of Jacob forever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end.

34 Then said Mary unto the angel, How shall this be, seeing I know not a man?

35 And the angel answered and said unto her, <u>The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee</u>, <u>and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing</u> <u>which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God.</u>

Mark 4:14-15,20

14 **<u>The Sower soweth the word</u>**. (The Word of The Kingdom - Matt 13:19)

15 And these are they by the wayside, where the word is sown; but when they have heard, Satan cometh immediately, and taketh away the word that was sown in their hearts. (persecution, affliction, cares, deceitfulness of riches, lust of other things)

20 These are they which are sown on good ground; such as hear the word, and receive it, and bring forth fruit, some thirtyfold, some sixty, and some an hundred.

- Matthew 13:23 ... he that heareth the word, and understandeth it...
- Luke 8:15 ... having heard the word, keep it, and bring forth fruit with patience.

Mark 4: 25-32

25 <mark>For he that hath, to him shall be given</mark>: <mark>and he that hath not, from him shall be taken</mark> <mark>even that which he hath.</mark>

26 And he said, So is the kingdom of God, as if a man should cast seed into the ground;

27 And should sleep, and rise night and day, and the seed should spring and grow up, he knoweth not how.

28 For the earth bringeth forth fruit of herself; first the blade, then the ear, after that the full corn in the ear.

29 But when the fruit is brought forth, immediately he putteth in the sickle, <u>because the</u> <u>harvest is come</u>.

30 And he said, Whereunto shall we liken the kingdom of God? or with what comparison shall we compare it?

31 <u>It is like a grain of mustard seed, which</u>, <mark>when it is sown in the earth, is less than all</mark> the seeds that be in the earth:

32 But when it is sown, <mark>it groweth up</mark>, and becometh greater</mark> than all herbs, and shooteth out great branches ...

Romans 4:17-21

17 As it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations,) before him whom he believed, even God, who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were.

18 Who against hope believed in hope, that he might become the father of many nations, according to that which was spoken, So shall thy seed be.

19 And being not weak in faith, he considered not his own body now dead, when he was about an hundred years old, neither yet the deadness of Sara's womb:

20 He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; **but was strong in faith**, **giving glory to God**;

21 And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform.
